This is a notification that the Standards Advisory Group is proposing a change to the NMDP Standards. The intent of this change is to increase the number of facilities providing cord blood, adding to the inventory of quality cord blood units. This proposed interim standard has also been reviewed and is supported by the Cord Blood Advisory Group.

The proposed standard falls under Section 4.0000 of the NMDP Standards: Criteria for Participating Cord Blood Banks. Changes are italicized.

4.4100 Bank shall use the following facilities for NMDP activities:

4.4130 Cord blood sites accredited by CMS or other organizations with deemed status, or non-U.S. equivalent and/or birth centers accredited by the Commission for the Accreditation of Birth Centers (CABC).
